We are called to equip the Saints for the work of the ministry according to Eph 4:13 "till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ." CMM is called to equip the local church on a global scale.

Everything we do is based on relationship and faith. **Every CMM network member is responsible for raising their own support** (We are ready to supply you with *Partnership Development training* upon request.)

CMM raises funds for designated purposes such as specific missionaries, churches, and projects. We do not attempt to have general funds for meeting all requests. We raise funds as the Lord leads for specific people and purposes. Everyone, including the volunteers who work at CMM, have to raise their own support. It is a day by day faith reliance on HIM!

On rare occasions we have funds given to us for urgent needs or to help in disaster relief efforts. We evaluate all the numerous requests in front of us before agreeing to a **one-time** donation. If you receive support once from us do not think it will be every month.

If you already have partners who support you financially and they wish to send their funds for you through CMM we are equipped to provide the full range of donor relations (including tax donation receipts and year-end total giving letters.)

*** Please note: If your primary goal is to find an organization to financially support your ministry, CMM will not meet your expectations unless you already have a steady stream of donations you wish to have sent through CMM.**

Agreement To Serve God as a Missionary/Minister

Statement of understanding as a CMM Missionary/Minister

- CMM Member will be a man or woman of great prayer, staying attentive to the Spirit, knowing the voice of the Shepherd and regularly fasting.
- CMM Member agrees to endeavor to build trust and fellowship in building genuine, authentic relationships with the CMM home office and leaders. Members agree to annual review and interview process with assigned leaders to see how we can best serve our Network Members. Ordinations are subject to renewal annually based on home office leadership interview and review.
- CMM Member will act as an independent contractor, not an employee, and will receive a 1099 annually, if a US citizen.
- CMM Member will be responsible for carrying out God's vision and purpose with faith, prayer, support, and accountability offered by CMM leadership.
- CMM Member will not incur any debt on behalf of CMM, or its leaders.
- CMM Member will tithe to CMM-10% of income raised by CMM. CMM will forward to CMM Member all funds sent in by donors for that CMM Member on a monthly basis, less the 10% tithe withheld from funds designated for CMM Member in prior month.*
- CMM Members in the US and Canada will pay \$125.00 initially to be ordained by CMM and \$100.00 each year for administration, mailings, updates, and annual meetings. Attendance is not required at meetings but highly recommended, when possible.
- CMM Member will act at all times with the highest integrity, honor, and the character of Christ, as an ambassador of Jesus Christ. As in Galatians 6:1 moral failure will be handled with a council of elders and may result in immediate termination of relationship.
- CMM Member will study to show yourself approved, attend at least one meeting or conference per year held by CMM, if CMM Member is in the US, or if CMM leaders or appointed person or staff is in CMM Member's nation.
- CMM Member will notify CMM home office of possible church or school plant opportunities or other partnership opportunities. CMM Member understands CMM is a faith mission and makes no financial commitment unless God provides the funds.
- CMM Member pledges to notify promptly our Home Office of any major change or trial in the Member's life or family or ministry.
- CMM and leadership offers encouragement, support, direction, guidance, spiritual covering, prayers, donor relations, receipts, monthly reports, help in conference and seminar planning, and covenant relationship to CMM Member and family and intentionally does not desire to control, manipulate, limit, etc. any action of CMM Member and CMM Member's God-ordained directions. CMM-desires to come alongside the Lord and you, our CMM Member and bless and help in any as led by the Spirit of God.
